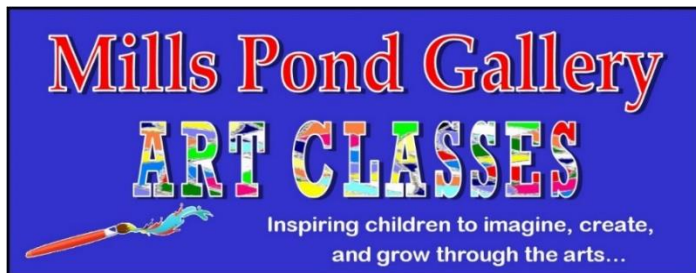

Art and Artist Ages 7-10 Learning about famous artist can be fun and even more exciting when we create art in the same style that the artist did! In this class we will learning about Vincent Van Gogh and paint our own Starry Night, explore Monet's Garden and even create a Cubist portrait Like Pablo Picasso! Teacher: Kim Falco
Monday - Friday August 7-11 1 pm - 4 pm

Explore Painting Ages 7-10 We will use different kinds of paint and paint on different kinds of surfaces... foil, wood and other found items. We will also explore different techniques and styles. We may even do a little messy drip painting! Dress for Mess! Teacher: Kim Falco

Cartooning Ages 7-10 Learn basic cartooning and storyboarding skills. We will create our own characters and storylines. Each student will produce their own original comic by the end of the class! Teacher: Kim Falco

Wednesday - Friday August 2 – August 4 9 am - 12 pm

Let's Paint! Landscapes Ages 12-14 Landscapes are an essential part of art history. In this class, students will create landscape paintings inspired by artists such as Van Gogh and J.M.W. Turner. Students will be shown how to use a variety of media, and will learn how to use their own marks and abstractions to create a sense of deep space within their landscapes. Teacher: Nicholas Frizalone
Wednesday - Friday August 2 – August 4 1 pm - 4 pm

Let's Paint! Animals Ages 10-12 We will explore different ways of painting animals. Each day, we will explore a different painting technique including watercolor, mixed media, oil pastel and acrylic. Students will utilize reference photos, and will learn how to not just paint an animal, but will learn how they can use different scenery and environments in a composition to make their images even more interesting. Everyday Animal Sculptures Week II Ages 5-7

A continuation of "Everyday Animal Sculptures Week I." Note: Week 1 participation is NOT necessary. New students are welcome to jump right in and join the fun! Build animals from everyday objects and recyclables such as empty water bottles, cardboard, foam, pine cones, sticks, duct tape and more! We'll begin by drawing our favorite critters, coloring them, and then taking them into the 3D world through sculpture! Papier mache and paint will be used, so things will get messy! No nice clothes, please!

Painting Landscapes and Seascapes Ages 5-7 Join us as we study the beautiful land and seascapes that surround us every day! We'll get a closer look at trees, bodies of water, sunsets, rainbows, clouds, fields of flowers and more! All paintings will be created in acrylic paint on canvas. Color is our friend and guide as we capture our beautiful world in strokes of light, swirls, dabs of a sponge!

Space Exploration through Art! Ages 5-7 Planets, stars, galaxies and nebulae...tricks of light born millions of years ago or nearby neighbors waiting to be explored? In this class, we'll learn about the mysteries of the night sky while making our own otherworldly art with paints, pastels and even some sculpture! Ever built a solar system before? Now's your chance!

Art and Ecology: "World of Water" Ages 5-7 We live on a beautiful planet. Come on a journey of learning about the natural world and its celebration through art. In "World of Water," we discuss the various plants and animals that inhabit our seas, oceans and wetlands and the roles these ecosystems play in the health of our planet. Art projects (primarily painting, but also some mixed media) will feature the ecosystem and animals of the day. We'll also discuss recycling and creating art out of "found objects."

Junior Masters: Impressionism and Beyond Ages 5-7 Master painters such as Van Gogh, Monet, Degas and Renoir lived over a hundred years ago, but their work still fascinates and inspires us to this day. In this class, we'll look at how these artists used light, color and brushstrokes to interpret life and we'll paint like they did! Most work will be done in acrylic on canvas, though we will also explore pastel and watercolor on paper.

Art and Ecology: "In the Trees" Ages 5-7 We live on a beautiful planet. Come on a journey of learning about the natural world and its celebration through art. In "In the Trees," we discuss the various plants and animals that inhabit our rain forests, temperate forests and tundras and the roles these ecosystems play in the health of our planet. Art projects (primarily painting, but also some mixed media) will feature the ecosystem and animals of the day. We'll also discuss recycling and creating art out of "found objects."

Junior Masters: Abstract Art Ages 5-7 Master painters such as Kandinsky, Mondrian, Pollack are known for bold painting styles that took art beyond the representational. We'll look at how these artists used color, shape and line to create a whole new exciting art form! Each day we'll create a new piece of abstract art working in acrylic paint on canvas.

Junior Art Sleuths: Discovery through Materials! Ages 6-8 Students will learn through exploration that a variety of materials can be used to create anything their imaginations can cook up!
