Students will gain an understanding of proportion and perspective and will experiment with various materials such as ink, charcoal, torn paper and some color mediums.

In "World of Water," we discuss the various plants and animals that inhabit our seas, oceans and wetlands and the roles these ecosystems play in the health of our planet. Art projects (primarily painting, but also some mixed media) will feature the ecosystem and animals of the day. We'll also discuss recycling and creating art out of "found objects."

Junior Masters: Impressionism and Beyond Ages 5-7 Master painters such as Van Gogh, Monet, Degas and Renoir lived over a hundred years ago, but their work still fascinates and inspires us to this day. In this class, we'll look at how these artists used light, color and brushstrokes to interpret life and we'll paint like they did! Most work will be done in acrylic on canvas, though we will also explore pastel and watercolor on paper.
